¹ In some cases the identity of the Respondent is unknown to the Complainant or the Complainant did not disclose the identity of the Respondent. Information on third party Respondents is not required per Executive Order 1095 (June 23, 2015).

² Investigations were not completed in cases where the Complainant did not pursue an investigation, and the use of interim remedies resolved the matter to the Complainant's satisfaction.

³ Investigations may commence in one fiscal year and be completed in the following fiscal year. Reports are resolved once an outcome is considered final. If a final outcome has not been determined before October 1st, the report is considered pending, and not counted per the Executive Order Annual Report requirements. Pending reports that are resolved during the next fiscal year are included in the following Annual Report's statistics. As of October 1, 2018, there were 13 investigations pending. From October 1, 2018- October 1, 2019, 7 of the 13 pending cases have resulted in final outcomes. Six cases from FY 17-18 remain pending. Eight cases from FY 18-19 remain pending as of October 1, 2019.

⁴ Four investigations from FY 17-18 resulted an insufficient evidence to hold the Respondent responsible and one investigation from FY 18-19 resulted in insufficient evidence to hold the Respondent responsible.

⁵ Case 1 (from FY 17-18): Respondent left University prior to the conclusion of the investigation, there is a hold on Respondent's account preventing reenrollment; Case 2 (from FY 17-18): 1 year suspension, 5 counseling sessions, 50 hours of community service, presentation and reflection paper.
